



Applications for 2019 scholarships are now being accepted.

Hi Friend,

We're happy to inform you that we're now accepting applications for 2019 eQuality Scholarships. eQuality is California's foremost program recognizing LGBT+ and ally youth for their **service to the LGBT+ community**. We award scholarships to graduating high school seniors, community college transfer students, undergraduate nursing students, and graduate health care students.

In 2018, eQuality awarded 19 scholarships totaling \$114,000. For 2019, we expect to award 20 or more **\$6,000** scholarships.

Applicants for the **high school** scholarships must:

- be a resident of northern or central California;
- have completed or complete high school or equivalent since 1 July 2014; and
- plan to attend or have begun attending an accredited post-secondary institution (college, university, or vocational/trade school) *for the first time* in 2019.

**New this year:** applicants residing in or attending high school in San Mateo or Santa Clara County are eligible for the PFLAG San Jose/Peninsula Scholarships.

**Also new this year:** we're expanding our scholarships for medical students to include other graduate health care fields - dentistry, pharmacy, physical therapy, and psychology. The eligibility requirements are somewhat different for the **graduate health care** scholarships,

as are the **community college transfer** and **undergraduate nursing** scholarship requirements. Please visit [www.equalityscholarship.org](http://www.equalityscholarship.org) for details.
